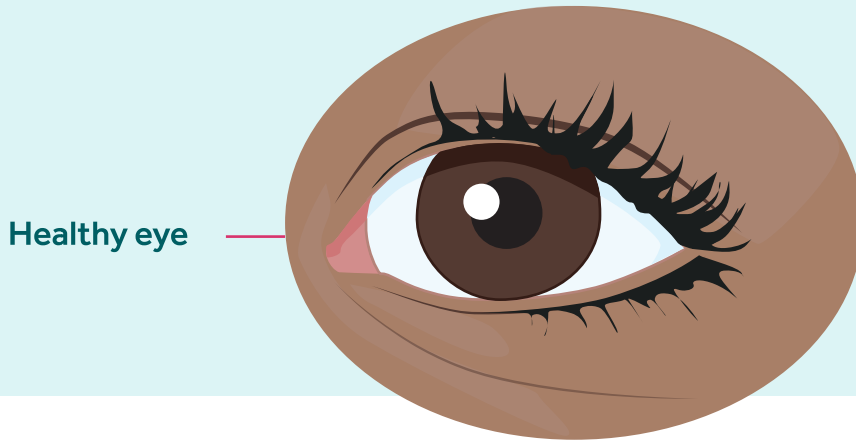


Symptoms of pink eye
