## Financial Impact of Falls **Among Older Adults**

Falls are the leading cause of injuries for older Americans, and many of them result in permanent disability and fatalities. 1 In addition to threatening the health and independence of seniors, falls also generate significant economic costs.2



One in four Americans aged 65+ falls each year<sup>2</sup>



About \$50 billion is spent on non-fatal fall injuries2



2.8 million injuries treated in emergency departments annually<sup>2</sup>



\$754 million is spent on fatal falls3



Over 800,000 hospitalizations each year<sup>2</sup>



The financial toll for older adult falls is expected to increase as the population ages and may reach \$101 billion by 2030.4

## Vision problems are among risk factors that makes older adults more likely to fall.<sup>5</sup>

To prevent falls, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends having your eyes checked by an eye doctor at least once a year, and be sure to update your eyeglasses if needed.5
