## About the US Senior Population



Approximately 18.4 percent of the U.S. population is covered by Medicare.<sup>1</sup>



Visual disorders become more common as people age.<sup>2</sup>





About one in four adults 65 and older cut back on food, utilities, clothing or medication due to healthcare costs.<sup>3</sup>



37% of adults 65 and older are concerned they will not be able to pay for needed healthcare services in the next year.<sup>3</sup>

## Eye Disease in Older Adults



In the United States, 20% of all people over the age of 85 experience permanent vision loss.<sup>5</sup>



75% of those who are legally blind because of glaucoma are seniors.<sup>6</sup>



More than half of all Americans age 80 or older either have cataracts or have had surgery to get rid of cataracts.<sup>7</sup>



The prevalence of diabetic retinopathy is rising in the elderly and is expected to reach 9.9 million by the year 2050.8



In seniors ages 65 and older, age-related macular degeneration (AMD) is the leading cause of vision loss and blindness.<sup>9</sup>
